The Blue Rose is a pure color between green and purple, and in nature is the rarest natural rose color. Blue is often emotionally associated with melancholy and depression, and more than 65% of patients with HIV experience clinically significant depression. Their depression stems from realistic feelings of insecurity, loss of control, and impending catastrophic illness. With this Blue Rose we embrace the virtue of Safety—freedom from risk of injury, danger, or loss—and Prevention—proactive decisions intended to maximize physical and Psychological wellness in the face of trials and tribulations.
